

Platte Valley Women's Healthcare, PC is pleased to offer all contraceptive options for our patients. Insurance coverage varies by plan. It is the patient's responsibility to find out if their preferred birth control method will be covered by their health insurance plan.

Most Women With Insurance Can Get Birth Control at No Cost

Paragard, Nexplanon, Liletta, Mirena, Kyleena, and Skyla are fully covered under most insurance plans—this may mean no co-pay, deductible or out-of-pocket costs.

Check with your insurance provider to confirm coverage related to your individual plan. Fees for the Contraceptive placement procedure may apply.

How to Check if Contraception Is Covered by Your Health Insurance

1. Call the customer service number on the back of your insurance card. Be sure to write down the names of any people you speak with and any reference number provided.
2. Tell them the name of your preferred contraception and that this is a healthcare provider-administered method of birth control (not a device) and that your physician will:
 - a) Be prescribing the device,
 - b) Order the device for you
 - c) Insert the device during an office visit
3. Ask them to check if your contraceptive is covered under the Affordable Care Act
4. Provide them with the J code for the device:
 1. Paragard: **J7300**
 2. Nexplanon: **J7307**
 3. Liletta: **J7297**
 4. Mirena: **J7298**
 5. Kyleena: **J7296**
 6. Skyla: **J7301**
5. Provide them with the CPT procedure code for insertion:
 1. IUD
 1. insertion: **58300**
 2. removal: **58301**
 2. Nexplanon
 1. insertion: **11981**
 2. removal: **11982**
 3. removal and reinsertion: **11983**

6. Ask if you will have any out-of-pocket costs, or if the contraceptive is only partially covered under your plan
7. Ask the person to send verification of coverage to your healthcare provider, if possible. Platte Valley Women’s Healthcare, PC Fax is 308-534-0091.
8. If written verification cannot be provided, write down the name of the person you spoke with and a reference number if available. Call and tell Platte Valley Women’s Healthcare what you’ve learned about your coverage, phone 308-534-0090.
9. Make an appointment with your healthcare provider to have your contraceptive inserted.

If your medical insurance says that your contraceptive is not covered as a medical benefit, then it may be covered as a pharmacy benefit. To check if it’s covered as a pharmacy benefit, call the customer service number on the back of your prescription card. Follow the steps above to determine pharmacy coverage.

What if My Health Insurance Doesn’t Cover my Contraception or I Don’t Have Health Insurance?

If you are age 24 or under, you may be able to get your contraception for free at People’s Health Clinic in North Platte. Their phone number is 308-534-3075. Their address is 102 S Elm St in North Platte.

Liletta The LILETTA Patient Savings Program® may help eligible patients with out-of-pocket costs for LILETTA. Eligible patients with commercial insurance pay \$100, then save up to a maximum of \$750, for the first LILETTA product.*

The LILETTA Patient Savings Program® may only be used toward the cost of LILETTA itself. It does not cover the cost of insertion of LILETTA or other costs from your healthcare provider's office.
